### Explore Two Local Dams!

Ever wondered about the Neponset River that's rumored to wind its way through your town and beneath your streets?

Come learn about this local, hidden treasure. Join an upcoming tour of the river's Baker Dam and Tileston & Hollingsworth Dam!

The Neponset River Watershed Association will lead a dam tour from 9:00 – 11:30AM on Saturday, June 12.

All interested parties should meet at 9:00AM at the new waterfront park between the Milton Yacht Club (small, brick building) and the Hood apartment complex on Wharf Street in Milton. Please wear sturdy shoes and bug repellent, and bring rain gear. The dam tour will happen rain or shine.

The tour will begin with a walk to the Baker Dam in Milton, move via a caravan of cars to Ryan Playground in Mattapan, and conclude at the Tileston & Hollingsworth Dam in Hyde Park. Expect to walk on dirt pathways and at times on uneven ground.

The dam tour will include a discussion of the history of the two Neponset River dams and how they have affected the river and the surrounding communities. Opportunities for river restoration will also be discussed.
